**REFLECTION:** Is the filling of your mind with Scripture & pondering on its meaning & application. **PRAYER:** God desires for you to know Him, have fellowship with Him, and to be involved in every area of your life. Prayer at any time & place is a major part of that. As building a relationship with a person requires consistent time with that person, in the same way, if you want to have a close relationship with God, you need to intentionally set aside daily time alone *just for God.* 

**MEMORIZATION:** Ask God for help; Say the Biblical reference before and after the verse; Read the verse aloud many times; Break the verse into natural phrases; Emphasize key words when quoting the verse; Write down the verse and erase a word one at a time; Write out the verse on a flash card and carry it with you or display it to review; Always memorize the verse "word perfect"; Get a partner & help each other; Repetition is key!
